

Proceedings of the meeting held on 23rd December 2021.

The meeting of Teacher's Council was presided over by Dr. Ramanuj Chakravorty, Principal and the President of Teacher's Council. At the outset he welcomed all the members and initiated the discussion agenda wise. He said that as per the decision of the last meeting of T.C. held on 27-11-2021 a meeting was convened on 16th December 2021 with all the earlier co-ordinators of IQAC and some other senior teachers to discuss the problem that came on the way of Krishnapada Das to continue as co-ordinator for which he expressed his inability in the meeting of last TC to continue as co-ordinator of IQAC. In the meeting of 16th December 2021, Sri Das once again expressed his inability categorically to continue as co-ordinator of IQAC. Teacher's present in the meeting discussed that somebody from amongst the earlier co-ordinators should be entrusted with the responsibility of IQAC as he had the exposure of the entire scheme of the things as co-ordinator of IQAC. He further said that two senior teachers who acted as co-ordinator Sri Saumitra Choudhury & Dr. Baharul Islam Mazumder respectively requested the teachers present in the meeting not to consider them taking their health condition into account. Principal, Dr. R Chakravorty then informed the house that what else was discussed in that meeting would be shared with the members present in the meeting by Sri Krishnapada Das and he requested Sri Das to inform the house, on this Sri Krishnapada Das informed the house as Dr. Sujit Tewari also acted as the co-ordinator of IQAC and he is the young and energetic and so it was decided that he should be made the co-ordinator of IQAC and his name was proposed by Sri Krishnapada Das as the coordinator of IQAC which was seconded by Dr. Samiran Debnath and that was accepted and supported by the entire house unanimously.

Dr. Sabyasachi Roy expressed dissatisfaction on various activities of Assam University relating to examination result publication.

Dr. B Bhattacharjee expressed great concern over the admission process of Master Degree in Assam University where it was found that students who passed degree with honours lagged behind and student of pass course were much ahead in the admission of Master Degree. Dr. B Bhattacharjee complained while selecting students for admission in M.A., the Admission Committee did not consider the result of Degree Course, instead they had taken the result of HSLC and HS into account. It was for this reason many students who could not perform satisfactory in the HSLC and HS Examination but did remarkably well in Degree Examination with outstanding performance in Honours paper

did not get admission in MA, though admission test was conducted, no weightage was given to honours students. Even a student who secured 86% in BA was not considered for admission in MA. The students faced difficulties the way admission last was conducted.

The house also criticized the action of the Deputy Registrar, Exam (TDC), the way he issued letter requesting the teachers to submit question papers for forth coming TDC Examination before 27th December 2021 in order to enable the university to moderate the question paper during 27 – 31 December 2021, whereas the university had sent the letters to teacher for setting question papers only on 22nd December.

Dr. Nibediata Bhattacharjee (Raul) who will be on superannuation on 31-12-2021 addressed the house.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks from and to the chair.

So a new T.C secretary is to be selected. He informed the house that the next senior most teacher Sri Saumitra Choudhury expressed his inability to take this responsibility on health ground.

Then the president initiated discussion on the Agenda I of the meeting. He informed the house that due to Covid situation the Platinum Jubilee celebration related programmes of Karimganj College could not be organised on due time. Bri Sudip Sukhabaidya, HOD, Dept of Computer Science then presented the "Karimganj College online platform" and explained its different features.





Proceedings of the Teachers Council meeting held on 28/11/2020:

The meeting was presided over by the principal, Dr. R.Chakraborty. At the outset he welcomed the members and then initiated discussion on first agenda. He expressed his dissatisfaction over the fact that the last NAAC assessment of this college was held in 2010 and next assessment could not be conducted though all of us have tried our level best. But it is very much need of the hour. In this context, he read out a letter dated 18/11/2020 from D.H. E which emphasized on NAAC accreditation with good score of all colleges of Assam as early as possible otherwise college will be deprived of all types of grant from RUSA etc.

He informed the house that Dr. S. Tiwari had resigned from post of IQAC coordinator and Sri Krishnapada Das has been appointed as IQAC Coordinator of the college and invited him to address the house.

K. Das discussed about the following points:

- (1) AQR for two consecutive academic years has not been sent and its work is going on.
- (2) Need for change in IQAC composition according to new guidelines.
- (3) Criteria of SSR to be carefully and critically presented which needs devotion and tenacity.
- (4) From first week of January'2021 work for IQAR and SSR to be started.



The meeting was presided over by Principal Dr. M.K.Bhattacharya.

Agenda I:

- e) There has been some infrastructure development in the college but overall development in all fronts is not satisfactory.

Agenda III:



4.2 The house urged upon the AUS authority to bring out the list of eligible teachers as paper examiners for the smooth running of Zones in different colleges under Assam University.


